

Protecting Our Children

Catholic Corner

The Concluding Rite at Mass occurs immediately after the Communion Rite. Then, just as the people were greeted at the beginning of the Mass, so now the priest greets the people again ("The Lord be with you") and blesses them in one of three forms: the Simple Form ("May almighty God bless you..."); or, at his discretion, the Solemn Blessing ("Bow your heads and pray for God's blessing"), which is used at various seasons or on specific feast days; or a Prayer Over the People. This is followed by the Dismissal: "Go in the peace of Christ" or "The Mass is ended, go in peace" or "Go in peace to love and serve the Lord."


